



QURBANI/UDHIY'YA REPORT 2007

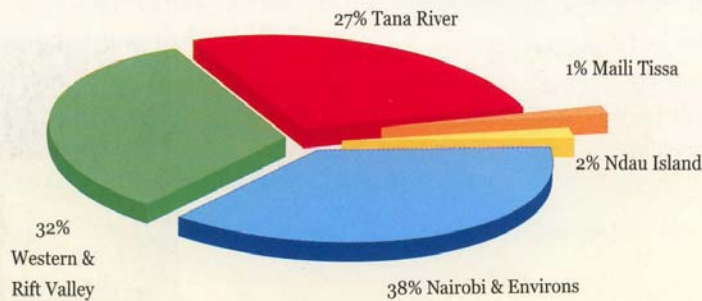
We are pleased to present our report on the Qurbani/ Udhij'ya distribution for the year 2007/ 1428 ah.

This year characterized a good response from the Muslim Ummah. A total of 1392 shares (goats) were slaughtered.

The distribution was done as follows: -

Summary Report of Distribution Areas.

Qurbani Distribution Chart



1) Tana River district;

372 Shares (goats) were allocated to the inhabitants of this district. The towns and villages covered included; Madogo, Mororo, Ziwani, Bakuyu amongst other villages in the surrounding areas.

2) Coast Province ; Ndau Island

25 shares were allocated to the needy Muslims in this Island.

3) Western & Rift Valley Provinces

64 Cows and 2 goats were slaughtered and distributed as follows: -

The following towns and villages were covered;

Mbale, Chepsonoi, Vihiga, Seremi, Matete, Webuye, Lumakanda, Kipkaren, Kiliboti, Turbo, Mbagara, Kitale, Centre Kwanza, Kolongoto among other villages. 4205 Needy Families benefited from this distribution.

4) Kajiado District; Maili Tissa.

20 Shares were slaughtered at our Alfurqan Institute, Maili Tissa Centre. The local Muslims populace and Namanga Islamic centre also benefited from this program.

5) Nairobi Area and environs

525 shares were allocated to the deserving dwellers of Nairobi area and its environs. The animals were slaughtered at our center in Nairobi with the meat being distributed to the slum areas namely; Quba Mosque, Baba Dogo, Riverside mosque and Sigona/Maguga. The beneficiaries were a large population of poor muslims residing in and near the said areas. 100 shares after slaughtering were distributed in Various Prisons in Nairobi. Other Towns and Institutes which gained from this include: Muranga, Karathe, Kagio, Girls Training Institute Pangani, Aisha Centre and Daarul Irshad among others.

1. Our members and volunteers witnessed the slaughtering and distribution of the animals and meat respectively.
2. All proceeds from this program will fund our various Daawah Activities.
